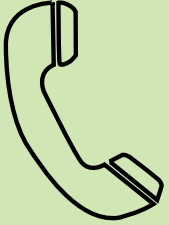

Thank you for your support and we look forward to seeing you!



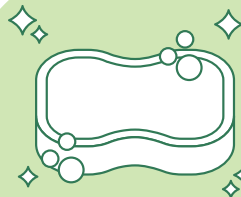
